**This is where you can find info regarding your child's classes, tuition, waiver, attendance, leveling etc.** Parents ***must*** accept the on-line Waiver prior to dancers being allowed to attend any classes.



**Tuition:** is Auto Drafted on the 1<sup>st</sup> of every month and considered late BY the 5<sup>th</sup> of every month. Auto draft is thru ACH, we do not accept Credit Cards. IF your preference is to pay cash for tuition, it becomes your responsibility prior to the 5<sup>th</sup> to make sure payment is made, in addition, *you will need to sign a form at front desk REQUESTING auto draft be turned off.*



**Communication:** Please make sure all your personal info is current. We use email and texting as our primary forms of communication. Please download the REMIND App. You will receive an email with your child's class code.



**Makeup Classes:** There are no refunds or credits given to absences due to illness, injury, or holidays. Students are ALWAYS allowed to makeup all missed classes in alternative classes of any style in their age group.



**Studio/Weather Cancellations:** Students will be notified prior to the class if it is canceled. Classes may be canceled without prior notice if an emergency occurs. In case of a weather-related closure, we will send an email & post on our social media. Edmond/OKC School closings do not determine DU closings. Decisions are made by 2pm.



**Medical:** Please provide any medical troubles and allergies to the front desk and the instructor. Face coverings are optional. If you wish to still wear one, you are more than welcome. As always, please stay home if you aren't feeling well! Thank you in advance



**Need to Cancel? We recommend giving your child 1 month to get acclimated. This allows them time to adjust to a new environment and create friendships with those in their class. But if needing to drop a class, here are details:**

**In order to drop a child from a class and stop payments for the upcoming month a drop form must be filled out and handed to or emailed in to front desk NO LATER THAN 3 DAYS PRIOR TO END OF MONTH.**

**There are **no** exceptions, and **no** refunds will be issued once tuition has been drafted.**



**Drop-Ins:** Students are allowed to drop-in to try a class for \$20. If the student wishes to enroll in class, the drop-in fee will be credited towards enrollment.



**TRASH Week** is the first FULL week of the month. This is the week that your child is welcome to wear fun leotards, tights, costumes, & skirts to class. Please make sure they're still able to dance in them & have proper shoes & hair pulled out of face

## **First up: Winter Performance – Sunday December 3rd , 23**

Costumes for this production will be on a smaller scale “pieces” /accessories and dancers will use their own leos & tights they have purchased for classes enrolled.

Starlette: \$70 per class bundle (ballpark) + \$20 Prod Fee

Junior: \$90 per class bundle (ballpark) + \$20 Prod Fee

Teen: \$90 per class bundle (ballpark) + \$20 Prod Fee

Ballpark meaning if costume is cheaper class will be credited for amounts not used.

Bundle Cost includes, Costume, Nanny Fee (Starlette/Juniors), Digital link to video and pictures, Bundle /Production Fees help to cover Auditorium rental, custodian fees, sound tech, Auditorium supervisor, Lights and Light Tech, Fly/Deck Coordinator, Music Licensing, Insurance Protection, Programs, Security, Ticketing Fees, Lobby Rentals, Dressing Room Rental, Backdrops, etc.

Winter Performance Fees will be drafted ON September 21<sup>st</sup>, 23.

## Spring Performance of “Encanto” – Week/Weekend of May 6<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> (Tentatively)

There are multiple shows presented. Students are encouraged to but **not** required to participate. *Those who do not wish to participate in either production you **must** let the front desk know, so charges can be removed from account before auto drafted.*

**Recital Bundle: \$110.00** / Split and Auto Drafted October 11<sup>th</sup> & November 11<sup>th</sup>  
Bundle includes Production Fee, One End of year T-shirt, Digital link to all performances, End of year Picture digital link from dress rehearsal.

Those that have performances in both year-end show and year end Aftershow will be charged an additional \$30.

**Performance Expenses:** Split and Auto Drafted October 11<sup>th</sup> & November 11<sup>th</sup>  
Costume prices range from \$70-\$100 per costume (Per Class/Per Performance)  
Tights \$12/\$15 for Starlettes and Juniors (Tights “should” be same for both productions)  
Nanny Fee \$12 per child/per Starlette, Jr Level One class (Per Performance)

Bundle Fees help to cover Auditorium rental, custodian fees, sound tech, Auditorium supervisor, Lights and Light Tech, Fly/Deck Coordinator, Music Licensing, Insurance Protection, Programs, Security, Ticketing Fees, Lobby Rentals, Dressing Room Rental, etc.

**Dress rehearsals** for the production are **mandatory** and you will not be allowed to participate in the production if you do not attend dress rehearsal.

**Tickets:** We do charge admission to our shows. Cost is decided by the facility rented and tickets will be sold online.

**End of Year - Production T-shirts** - T-shirts are part of the Bundle. All students will be ordered a Recital T-shirt. Size requests need to be submitted no later than Jan 31<sup>st</sup>. If a size is not submitted one will be selected for you as follows; A Starlette dancer will be ordered a Child Large, a junior level dancer will be ordered an Adult Small, and a Teen dancer will be ordered an Adult Medium.

**Fine Print:** If the theatre rental, or any of the vendors for the tickets, T-shirts or DVDs increase their prices, fees will be subject to change.

Once you have paid for your costume and production fee it is **NON-REFUNDABLE** and **NON-TRANSFERABLE** even if you paid before the **FIRST** deadline. So be 100% **SURE** that your child wants to be in the recital!

If you enroll **after** November 1<sup>st</sup> (for Winter Production) and December 1<sup>st</sup> (for Spring Production), of the current year: dancers can still participate in production, there will be a second order placed for costumes mid to late January.

Please note the fee will be higher and costumes are **not** guaranteed for picture day. There will be no costumes ordered after the second deadline.

Dance Unlimited & Spotlight Acting Academy pride ourselves on transparent communication with all families and students. Our primary form of communication is email. Please make sure that you're receiving emails from Dance Unlimited, and we are not going into your spam folder. It's also, very important to check with the front desk often whenever your contact information changes.
