This is where you can find info regarding your child's classes, tuition, waiver, attendance, leveling etc. Parents must accept the on-line Waiver prior to dancers being allowed to attend any classes.



Tuition: is Auto Drafted on the 1st of every month and considered late BY the 5th of every month. Auto draft is thru ACH, we do not accept Credit Cards. IF your preference is to pay cash for tuition, it becomes your responsibility prior to the 5th to make sure payment is made, in addition, *you will need to sign a form at front desk REQUESTING auto draft be turned off.*



Communication: Please make sure all your personal info is current. We use email and texting as our primary forms of communication. Please download the REMIND App. You will receive an email with your child's class code.



Absences & Makeup Classes: Please email or call to notify the studio of student absences. There are no refunds or credits given to absences due to illness, injury, or holidays. However, students are ALWAYS allowed to makeup missed classes in alternative classes of any style in their age group.



Studio/Weather Cancellations: Students will be notified prior to the class if it is canceled. Classes may be canceled without prior notice if an emergency occurs. In case of a weather-related closure, we will send an email & post on our social media. Edmond/OKC School closings do not determine DU closings. Decisions are made by 2pm.



Medical: Please provide any medical troubles and allergies to the front desk and the instructor. Face coverings are optional. If you wish to still wear one, you are more than welcome. As always, please stay home if you aren't feeling well! Thank you in advance



Need to Cancel? We recommend giving your child 1 month to get acclimated. This allows them time to adjust to a new environment and create friendships with those in their class. But if needing to **drop a class**, here are details: In order to drop a child from a class and stop **payments** for the upcoming month a drop form must be filled out and handed in at the front desk or emailed NO LATER THAN 3 DAYS PRIOR TO END OF MONTH. There are **no** exceptions, and **no** refunds will be issued once tuition has been drafted.



Drop-Ins: Students are allowed to drop-in to try a class for a small fee. If the student wishes to enroll in class, the drop-in fee will be credited towards enrollment.



TRASH Week is the first FULL week of the month. This is the week that your child is welcome to wear fun leotards, tights, costumes, & skirts to class. Please make sure they're still able to dance in them & have proper shoes & hair pulled out of face.

Communication

Please download the Remind App. You will receive an email with your class code(s). Please make sure that you're receiving emails from Dance Unlimited and that we are not going into your spam folder. It's also very important to check in with the front desk often whenever your contact information changes.

What to wear?

Jr One Ballet - Any Shade of Purple or Black Leotard, Black, Chiffon Wrap Skirt (Tie or Elastic)

Tights: Pink footed or convertible tights. - Shoes: Split Sole, Capezio or Bloch Pink Ballet shoes, must be leather. Cut drawstrings about half inch, make a bow, THEN tuck inside of ballet shoe.

Dance tights serve as your child's "under garment"
Dancers Hair should be in a bun; even short hair will need to be secured out of face

Jr One Jazz/Tap - Any Shade of Purple or Black Leotard, Black tights or leggings, No Shorts.

Jazz Shoes: Black Bloch 401L slip-on split sole

Tap Shoes: BLACK CAPEZIO or BLOCH leather style shoe. Must have Tele Tone Taps on bottom



Jr Two Ballet - Any Shade of Red or Black Leotard, Black, Chiffon Wrap Skirt (Tie or Elastic)

Tights: Pink footed or convertible tights. Shoes: Split Sole, Capezio or Bloch Pink Ballet shoes, must be leather. Cut drawstrings about half inch, make a bow, THEN tuck inside of ballet shoe

Dance tights serve as your child's "under garment"
Dancers Hair should be in a bun; even short hair will need to be secured out of face

Jr Two Jazz/Tap - Any Shade of Red or Black Leotard, Black tights or leggings, No Shorts.

Jazz Shoes: Black Bloch 401L slip-on split sole

Tap Shoes: BLACK CAPEZIO or BLOCH leather style shoe. Must have Tele Tone Taps on bottom

Jr Three Ballet - Any Shade of Green or Black Leotard, Black, Chiffon Wrap Skirt (Tie or Elastic)

Tights: Pink footed or convertible tights. - Shoes: Split Sole, Capezio or Bloch Pink Ballet shoes, must be leather. Cut drawstrings about half inch, make a bow, THEN tuck inside of ballet shoe
NO PANTIES, dance tights serve as your child's "under garment". Dancers Hair should be in a bun; even short hair will need to be secured out of face

Jr Three Jazz - Any Shade of Green or Black Leotard, Black Tights or Black leggings, No Shorts.

Jazz Shoes: Black Bloch 401L slip-on split sole

Jr Three Tap - Any Shade of Green or Black Leotard, Black, Black Tights or Black leggings, No Shorts.

Shoes: BLACK CAPEZIO or BLOCH leather style shoe. Must have Tele Tone Taps on bottom.

Teen Two Ballet - Any Shade of Maroon or Black Leotard, Black, Chiffon Wrap Skirt (Tie or Elastic)
Tights: Pink footed or convertible tights. Shoes: Split Sole, Capezio or Bloch Pink Ballet shoes, must be leather. Dancers Hair should be in a bun; even short hair will need to be secured out of face

Teen Two Jazz - Any Shade of Maroon or Black Leotard/Tank, Black Tights or Black leggings, No Shorts. Jazz Shoes: Black Bloch 401L slip-on split sole

Teen Two Tap - Any Shade of Maroon or Black Leotard, Black Tights or Black leggings, No Shorts. Tap Shoes: BLACK CAPEZIO or BLOCH leather style shoe. Must have Tele Tone Taps on bottom. All upper-level tap dancers are strongly encouraged to wear Jason Samuels, K360, or Miller and Ben Style shoes.

Teen Three Ballet - Any Shade of Purple or Black Leotard, Black, Chiffon Wrap Skirt (Tie or Elastic)
Tights: Pink footed or convertible tights. Shoes: Split Sole, Capezio or Bloch Pink Ballet shoes, must be leather. Dancers Hair should be in a bun; even short hair will need to be secured out of face

Teen Three Jazz - Any Shade of Purple or Black Leotard/Tank (if tight fitting), Black Tights or Black leggings, No Shorts. Jazz Shoes: Black Bloch 401L slip-on split sole

Teen Three Tap - Any Shade of Purple or Black Leotard/Tank (if tight fitting), Black tights or Black leggings, No Shorts. Tap Shoes: Jason Samuels, K360, or Miller and Ben Style shoes.

Teen Four Ballet - Any Shade of Blue or Black Leotard, Black, Chiffon Wrap Skirt (Tie or Elastic)
Tights: Pink footed or convertible tights.
Shoes: Split Sole, Capezio or Bloch Pink Ballet shoes, must be leather.
Dancers Hair should be in a bun for all of class.

Teen Four Jazz - Any Color Leotard/Tank (if tight fitting) and Tights or leggings, NO Shorts allowed
Jazz Shoes: Tan and Black Bloch 401L slip-on split sole

Teen Four Tap - Any Color Leotard/Tank (if tight fitting) and Tights or leggings, NO Shorts allowed. Tap Shoes: Jason Samuels, K360, or Miller and Ben Style shoes.

Teen Five Ballet - Any Color Solid Leotard, Black, Chiffon Wrap Skirt (Tie or Elastic)
Tights: Pink footed or convertible tights.
Shoes: Split Sole, Capezio or Bloch Pink Ballet shoes, must be leather.
Dancers Hair should be in a bun.

Teen Five Jazz - Any Color Leotard/Tank (if tight fitting) and Tights or leggings, NO Shorts allowed
Jazz Shoes: Tan and Black Bloch 401L slip-on split sole

Teen Five Tap - Tights: Black tights or Black leggings, No Shorts. Tap Shoes: Jason Samuels, K360, or Miller and Ben Style shoes.

Hip Hop: (all levels) Comfortable clothing such as leggings and tank tops, Tennis shoes, NO jeans!

DANCE PRODUCTION INFO

DU Winter Showcase – December 11th
Spring Performance – Week/Weekend of May 8th – 13th

There will be multiple shows presented. Participation is encouraged, but not required. **Students who do not wish to participate in the productions must let the front desk know BEFORE the required deadlines to avoid being charged.** Each class will have to be uniform in their tights, shoes, and hair for production; this may involve buying new tights and painting shoes! All dress rehearsals for productions are mandatory and you will not be allowed to participate in the performances if you do not attend required dress rehearsals.

Winter Showcase Performance Expenses

All expenses for the winter showcase are divided into two payments.

First Payment Due Date: October 11th, 2022

Second Payment Due Date: November 3rd, 2022

Winter Bundle: **\$140.00**

Includes: *1 Costume/Headpiece *Participation fee * Digital download of the performance * Holiday souvenir

Additional costumes: **+\$50 per class**

Year-End Recital Performance Expenses

All expenses for the year-end recital are divided into two payments:

First Payment Due Date: November 15th, 2022

Second Payment Due Date: December 15th, 2022

STARLETTE \$200 – Additional costume \$75

JUNIORS \$215 – Additional costume \$85

TEENS \$230 – Additional costume \$100

Production Fee \$50 **per** show (Recital vs. Aftershow)

Costume/Headpiece/Prop * All Digital Downloads * T-shirt * All Tights * Nanny (If applicable)

Bundle fees help to cover Auditorium rental, custodian fees, sound tech, Auditorium supervisor, Lights and Light Tech, Fly/Deck Coordinator, Music Licensing, Insurance Protection, Programs, Security, Ticketing Fees, Lobby Rentals, Dressing Room Rental, etc.

Dress rehearsals for the production are **mandatory** and you will not be allowed to participate in the production if you do not attend dress rehearsal.

Tickets: DU does charge for admission to the productions. Ticket costs are decided by the facility rented and can be purchased through their box offices. Production t-shirts/souvenirs and video recordings are included in the “Winter Bundle” and “Recital Bundle” for each family! ***All fees are subject to change based on the prices determined by the theatre rental and vendors.***

End of Year - Production T-shirts - T-shirts are part of the Bundle. All students will be ordered a Recital T-shirt. Size requests need to be submitted no later than Jan 31st. If a size is not submitted one will be selected for you as follows; A Starlette dancer will be ordered a Child Large, a Junior level dancer will be ordered an Adult Small, and a Teen dancer will be ordered an Adult Medium.

Tickets: We offer the chance for you to advertise your business in our programs, which reach over 1,000 audience members each year. Personal ads for your dancer are also welcome.

Fine Print:

If the theatre rental or any of the vendors for tickets, t-shirts, or DVDs increase their prices, fees will be subject to change.

Once you have paid for your costume and production fee it is **NON-REFUNDABLE and NON-TRANSFERABLE** even if you paid before the FIRST deadline. So be 100% SURE that your child wants to perform in the recital!

If you enroll **after** November 1st (for Winter Production) or **after** December 1st (for Spring Production), of the current year: dancers can still participate in production, there will be a second order placed for costumes. After the second order, we cannot guarantee that costumes will be available to arrive in time for the performance.

Please note the fee will be higher and costumes are **not** guaranteed for recital picture day. There will be no costumes ordered after the second deadline.
